The piece sizes used varied from 2ft x 2ft, 4ft diameter and 4ft x 3ft – with one side having a radius and angled cuts to match up with the 4ft diameter pieces. In addition to the detailed cuts involved, there was also the matter of some intricate seam work.

"The seams needed to be less than 1/16 of an inch," said Waterjets Unlimited President Mark Grindel, "in order to meet the architect's plans."

The work was done on behalf of Waterjets' customer Lido Stone Works, of Calverton, New York.
